**GENERAL ORDER 20**

It is **ORDERED**: that absent direction from a Judicial Officer of the Northern District indicating otherwise, Clerk's Office personnel shall not accept cash as collateral for bail. Bail may be posted with other forms of legal tender including but not limited to money orders and bank certified checks. Personal Checks and Credit Cards cannot be accepted for the posting of Bail.

This General Order shall become effective immediately upon filing.
