**IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZATION FOR
PROBATION OFFICERS TO CARRY FIREARMS**

GENERAL ORDER 21

It appearing that to insure their safety, the Probation office of this Court may require the carrying of firearms in the execution of their official duties.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED, that when qualified and authorized by the Chief Probation Officer and in compliance with the Court's Policy related to firearms as promulgated through the Chief Probation Officer and such other conditions as prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States and the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, each regularly appointed Probation Officer of this Court is authorized to carry a firearm for protection during the performance of his or her duties.

The attached Firearms Policy supersedes this Courts preexisting firearms policy.
