## IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING THE U.S. PROBATION OFFICE'S COMPUTER AND INTERNET MONITORING PROGRAM

## **GENERAL ORDER #10**

A special condition of supervision is frequently used in the Northern District of New York which calls for a defendant or offender to not use or possess any computer, data storage device or any internet capable device unless the defendant or offender participates in the Computer and Internet Monitoring Program. The U.S. Probation Office oversees said program and has provided the Board of Judges with the Program Conditions/Rules, a Computer and Internet Data Form, a Computer and Internet Data Modification Form, and a Third Party Internet Notification Form which each defendant or offender subject to the aforementioned condition must execute. The Board of Judges has reviewed the program rules and related forms and finds the program meets the ends of justice sought when imposing said condition.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the U.S. Probation Office shall continue to oversee the Computer and Internet Monitoring Program as outlined in the current rules and related forms as approved by the Board of Judges for the Northern District of New York.
