
General Order #11

In the Matter of the issuance of Grand Jury Subpoenas  
and the use of the Department of Justice Grand Jury Tracking System  
\*\*\*\*\*

The Department of Justice has created an automated Grand Jury Tracking System (“GJTS”) which is designed to prepare and track grand jury Subpoenas. The Court having considered the application of the United States Attorney’s Office for the Northern District of New York to use a signed and sealed but other wise blank Grand Jury Subpoena form issued by the Clerk pursuant to Fed. R. Cr. P. 17(a) in their (“GJTS”) system.

It is hereby ORDERED that: the Clerk of Court may issue to the United States Attorney a blank Grand Jury Subpoena, signed and sealed for use in their (“GJTS”) system. Use of the blank, signed and sealed Subpoena form shall be limited to the issuance of Grand Jury Subpoenas only by the U.S. Attorney.
