
ORDER LIMITING THE POSSESSION OF FIREARMS AND WEAPONS IN
THE COURTHOUSES AND COURTROOMS
OF THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF NEW YORK

GENERAL ORDER #6

Pursuant to the recommendation of the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is hereby ORDERED, that the possession of firearms and weapons in any Courtroom on any Court floor in this District where there is a Courtroom or Judges chambers shall be limited to the following people: Court Security Officers and United States Marshals Service law enforcement personnel, or their duly authorized agents.

It is Further ORDERED, that the possession of firearms and weapons in the four federal Courthouses in the Northern District of New York, outside of Court floors located at Albany, Binghamton, Syracuse and Utica shall be limited to the following people: Federal Protective Service law enforcement personnel, Court Security Officers, United States Marshals Service law enforcement personnel, or their duly authorized agents, and any agent of another tenant agency authorized to carry such firearm or weapon by the agency, as long as said agent is known by the U.S. Marshals.
