Irregular or Inappropriate Documents for Filing Pilot Program

NOTICE:

Irregular or inappropriate documents presented for filing in the Clerk's Office

All documents submitted for filing which the Clerk of Court believes to appear irregular, or otherwise inappropriate for filing, shall be forwarded to the Chief Judge, or their designee, for a determination as to whether the document should be filed.

Examples of such documents include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. Documents purporting to renounce or establish citizenship
- 2. Non-consensual liens
- 3. Registration of Judgments from "common law" courts.
- 4. Documents with captions that do not properly identify this Court.

The Clerk's Office will accept the document(s) upon presentation for filing. Court staff will not mark the document(s) as filed or received unless and until approval is granted by a judicial officer.

Upon approval, the document(s) will be filed, and the filing fee will be collected, if applicable, or the documents will be entered on the docket of a pending action.

Documents that are ultimately rejected by the Court shall be returned to the party submitting them in their original form without any Court stamp or markings.
